GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

These instructions should be read carefully and retained after installation by the end user for future reference and maintenance.

These instructions should be used to aid installation of the following products;

WALL1L, WALL2L, WALL3L, WALL1LBK, WALL2LBK, WALL3LBK, WALL1LC, WALL2LC, WALL3LC

SAFETY:

- Installation of this luminaire should only be carried out by a qualified electrician or competent person to the latest Building and current IEE Wiring Regulations (BS7671)
- Please isolate mains prior to installation/maintenance
- Check the total load on the circuit (including when this luminaire is fitted) does not exceed the rating of the circuit cable, fuse or circuit breaker
- Please note the IP (Ingress of Protection) rating of this luminaire when deciding the location for installation
- This product series is Class I
- This product series is IP65 rated

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS:

- Provide power to the required point of installation. Suitable IP rated junctions boxes should be used where required

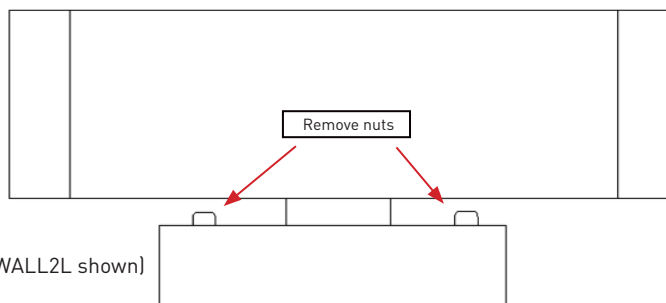


Fig 1 (WALL2L shown)

- Using a 7mm spanner, remove the 2 nuts securing the base plate of the luminaire (see Fig 1

- Using the base plate as a template mark the location of the fixing holes, and drill the holes ensuring not to infringe with any joists, gas or water pipes or electrical cables
- Feed mains cable through the rubber grommet to retain IP rating, and secure base plate to the desired surface
- Ensuring correct polarity is observed, carefully wire as shown in Fig 2

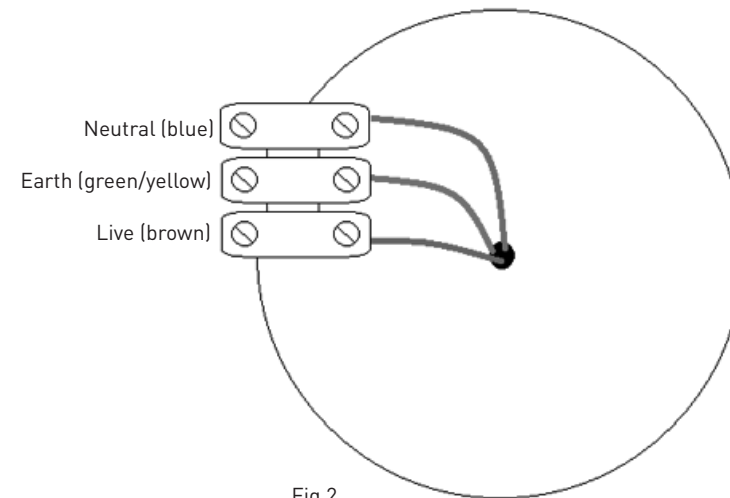
