Installation:

- Turn the power off before commencing installation (see Fig.1).
- Cut a suitable hole in the ceiling as as per the cut-out details ensuring that it does not infringe with electrical cables, water/gas pipes or ceiling joists. (see Fig.2).
- The downlight is IC Rated and designed for use with insulated material, it does not need extra IC cage accessories.
- Connect the driver to the downlight (see Fig.3).
- Install the required reflector white and black reflectors included.(see Fig.4).
- Insert the LED module into the bracket.(see Fig.5).
- Fit the downlight into the hole in the ceiling with the 2 spring clips supplied. (see Fig.6).
- Test for correct operation.
- If you need to remove the downlight use a rubber suction cup & pull down (suction cup not included).
