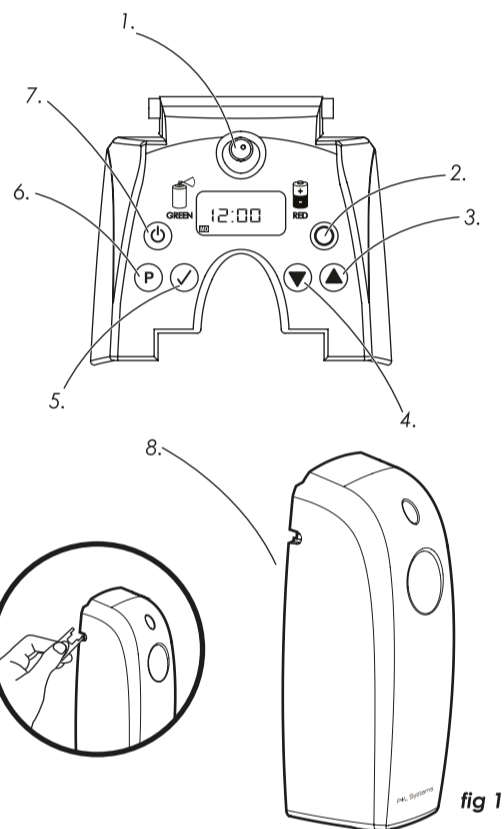

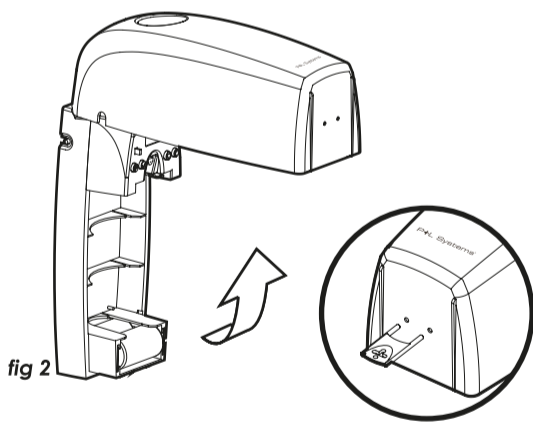

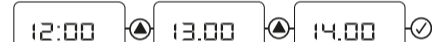
### 02 Installation

- Open the dispenser using the supplied key. (fig 2)
- Offer the dispenser up to the mounting surface and mark the two fixing holes with a pencil.
- NB. The dispenser should ideally be positioned at least 2m (7ft) from ground level.**
- Drill the two marked fixing positions and fit the dispenser in position using the two supplied wall plugs and screws.
- Once installed, insert a P+L Systems Washroom aerosol fragrance and two 'C' size batteries, observing the correct orientation.
- Press the ON/OFF button (7) to turn the dispenser on.
- NB. The LED will flash red 4 times and a test spray will follow. Take care to ensure that you are not sprayed in the face.**

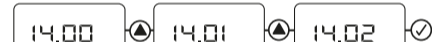
### 03 Clock set

To begin programming press (P)

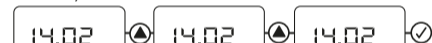
Set Time - Hours

### 04 Factory Settings

- The dispenser is factory set to run at 15 minute intervals, 24 hours / day, 7 days / week.
- With factory settings, your aerosol will last one month.
- The factory settings can be changed as shown in the 'Programming' section of these instructions.
- Continue to step 5 - Programming.

If the warning symbol starts flashing, the 'spray interval' is longer than the 'active spray time.'



Please reprogramme so the 'spray interval' is shorter, or the 'active spray time' is increased.

### 06 Maintenance



- Green Replace Aerosol
- Red Replace Batteries

#### - Aerosol Replacement

- Turn the unit off using the ON/OFF button. (7)
- Replace the used aerosol with the new can
- Turn on the unit using the ON/OFF button. (7)

**NB. The LED will flash red 4 times and a test spray will follow. Take care to ensure that you are not sprayed in the face.**

- Reset the spray counter by pressing the RESET button. (2)
- The LED will flash green once and then red once after the reset button has been pressed.

#### - Battery Replacement

- Turn the unit off using the ON/OFF button. (7)

**NB. The batteries must be replaced within 60 seconds to ensure that the current programme settings are retained.**

- Replace the used batteries with the new set
- Turn on the unit using the ON/OFF button. (7)

**NB. The LED will flash green 4 times and a test spray will follow. Take care to ensure that you are not sprayed in the face.**

- If a manual test spray is required, use the key to activate the exterior test spray button (3) as shown in fig 1
