User Manual

A lightweight, compact desk fan with 1 speed setting and adjustable, tilting head. Ideal for desks at home and work, it is quiet yet powerful with USB connection and a stylish finish.




Features:

- Quiet yet powerful 3W motor

Assembly Diagram:

- 1. Fan blade
- 2. Grille
- 3. Stand frame
- 4. USB power outlet
- 5. Power switch







Operation:

- 1. Set the fan on a dry, level and secure surface and do not hang or mount on a wall or ceiling.
- 2. Connect the fan to a suitable USB power source using the 1.1m power lead and plug.
- 3. To turn the fan on and off, press power switch (5) at the back of the unit.
- 4. To adjust the tilt of the fan, simply move the head unit up or down, selecting the desired gradient.

Cleaning the fan blades:

To clean the fan blades and keep them free from dust and dirt, disconnect the fan from the USB supply and clean using a soft brush. The grille may also be cleaned using a soft damp cloth, but never use any liquids or detergents.

Warnings:

- For reasons of electrical safety, this device must never be immersed in water, exposed to damp conditions or
 excessive force.
- Do not use this device if you find that it is damaged in any way.
- Do not attempt to repair this device or take apart under any circumstances, as this will invalidate your warranty.
- Never cover the fan or place anything on the grilles, as this may result in overheating or fire.
- Never allow foreign objects to be pushed into the motor, or fan blades as this may result in fire, injury or damage to the fan.
